Classes will be divided for Rough and Smooth dogs and bitches. A neutered male may enter the Veteran Dog Class & a spayed bitch may enter the Veteran Bitch Class. 1st place winners compete for Best of Breed.

BEST OF VARIETY/BREED COMPETITION

Best of Variety/Best of Breed Competition - The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Variety or Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records.

BRED-BY EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC, the person handling the dog must be a breeder of record and an owner or co-owner of the dog.

BEST BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (SATURDAY AM ONLY): For first place winners in the Bred-By Exhibitor classes (Adult & Puppy) from both Rough and Smooth. The person handling the dog in the class **MUST** be a breeder of record and an owner or co-owner of record and the dog must be individually registered at the time entries are made with the AKC. For complete rules refer to Chapter 3, Section 8 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

BEST PUPPY (SUNDAY AM ONLY): For first place winners in the Puppy 6-9 & 9-12 month Classes from both Rough and Smooth.

FOUR-TO-SIX MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION

The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for Collies that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. The competition is not divided by sex. The judge will select Best of Variety 4-6 Beg Puppy & Best Opposite Sex to Variety then Best of Breed-4-6 Beg Puppy from all puppies entered in the competition. AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin. All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol. Entry Fee: \$15.00.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP – ALL SHOWS

NOVICE CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the American Kennel Club are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

MASTER CLASS: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

NOVICE AND OPEN CLASS DIVIDED:

- **Junior-9** years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show
- **Intermediate-12** years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show
- **Senior-15** years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

BEST JUNIOR HANDLER: Winners from each class will compete for Best Junior Handler.

NOTICE: Junior Handlers must include their AKC JUNIOR HANDLER NUMBER on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC, Judges Education Department, (919) 233-9767. BE SURE ALL INFORMATION for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of entry form.

Bitches in season are not eligible to be shown in Junior Showmanship Classes. At a Specialty show, each dog must be of the breed for which the show is held. A dog that has been rejected - dismissed or excused by the veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused, may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

NOTE: SUBSTITUTION OF DOG IN JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP AT THE SHOW(S): There will be an Administration Fee of \$5.00 charged for any substitution of dog in Junior Showmanship at each show. Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered and shown in one of the breed classes at the show or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog that must be withdrawn for good and sufficient reason, such as a bitch in season or a veterinarian's excuse may be replaced by another dog meeting the same requirements. Such substitution must be requested in writing stating the reason for the substitution and must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form.

All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Event Secretary advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed. If a trophy listed is unavailable, a trophy of equal or greater value will be awarded.

CHALLENGE TROPHIES

Saturday AM - Best of Breed: The Collie Club of Colorado offers the Blue Beard Memorial Trophy, a 12" x 18" Sterling Silver Serving Dish with cover. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the exact owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. Until retired, this trophy will remain in the possession of the Collie Club of Colorado. (Trophy valued at \$1700)

Sunday AM – Best of Breed: The Collie Club of Colorado and Jerry & Haydee Kuner offers the Glen Twiford Memorial Trophy, a bronze sculpture of CH. Wind Call's Ballerina. Glen Twiford was one of the founding members of the Collie Club of Colorado and the artist of this bronze sculpture. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the exact owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog nor at consecutive shows. Until retired, this trophy will remain in the possession of the Collie Club of Colorado. (Trophy valued at \$4500)

Sunday AM - Best Puppy Challenge: The Diane Boberick Memorial Trophy: A bronze sculpture of a playful Collie sitting on a braided rug by PiperAnne Worcester.

The trophy shall be awarded to the Best Puppy (chosen from the winners of the puppy classes). A plaque with the name of the owner and the dog will be permanently attached to the base of the trophy. The owner will receive an orange and blue rosette commemorating the win. For permanent possession, this trophy must be won three times by the exact same registered owner(s), not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows. Until retired this trophy will remain in the possession of the Collie Club of Colorado (Trophy valued at \$2000.00).

SHOW SITE & EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- The Show Site will be available to exhibitors Saturday at 7 am to 8 pm, Sunday 7 am to 6 pm. Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.
- No ex-pens allowed in building.
- Depending on the entry you may be asked to stack crates.
- The show grounds constitute the building & the outside grounds and parking lot.
- All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the Show Committee of this show giving club on this day will be strictly enforced, including and not recorded in this Premium List.
- Grooming will be allowed in the building. Blow dryers in the building will be determined first day of the shows. There is NO dog wash available during these shows.
- No generators to be operated within 100 feet of any ring during judging times.
- Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and set up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs, dogs they are exhibiting, or which are under their care or control AT ALL TIMES. This requirement includes both while in the ring or at any location on our show site. Clean up tools and supplies will be available at each ring and at other convenient locations through-out the show grounds. Ring Stewards will be glad to hold your dog while you clean up.
- Dumping of dog food or grooming residue into the restroom sinks and toilets is strictly prohibited!
- NO dogs will be allowed in the restrooms. NO un-entered dogs allowed on the show grounds.
- No baby strollers are allowed in the show buildings. Parents are solely responsible for their children and are expected to keep them supervised and controlled at all times for their own safety.
- No double handling will be permitted at these shows. Individuals who attempt to double handle from outside the ring will be subject to action by the Show Committee.
- There shall be no drilling or intensive /abusive training of dogs on the show grounds.
- Dogs must be in control at all times. This includes the use of Flexi leashes.
- No crating or grooming allowed in any aisles or within 10' of show rings. Please keep aisles clear.

3. **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DogZibit will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. We will not re-process checks. The exhibitor will be contacted & required to send a money order for the original amount PLUS the \$30.00 NSF fee. Subsequent returned checks from same person may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY BASIS.
4. **Exhibitors' entry acknowledgements** will be made as soon as practicable by email to the address given on the entry blank. If not received by the end of the closing date, notify DogZibit. Judging programs will be sent at least a week prior to the show.
5. **No refunds of entry fees** when a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. There is no refund for duplicate entries or overpayments. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event, it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. 6. **Refunds** for cancellations due to judge change or cancellations made prior to entries closing will be mailed by the Club to said Exhibitor or Agent AFTER THE SHOW. An administrative fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.
7. The Club may **decline any entries** for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, & no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
8. An AKC Recording Fee of \$50 first entry only and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. For Rally Trials the fee is \$3.50 for each first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.
9. Dogs, which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made to the DogZibit at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
10. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor DogZibit will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
11. Only dogs eligible for these shows will be admitted into the show area. There is no provision for unentered dogs. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in exercising ring.
12. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
13. The Club, DogZibit, their agents, employees, etc., will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will **assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury** sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property participating in these shows, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children at these shows. **Please do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.** All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
14. **All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote** or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the Club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent. The Club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at the show.
15. Please note: Any hotel or motel listed in the premium list is subject to Event Committee Rules. We expect our exhibitors to be responsible guests. A report that an exhibitor at this show has abused hotel or motel property during this weekend may result in disciplinary action. Clubs reserve the right to decline future entries from the offending party in accordance with the provisions of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows.
